The creative process goes something like this:

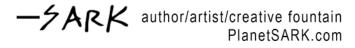
- 1. Wow, I have a great idea!

Suggested Uses For This Book

Use the poems as prompts for your own writing: Read a poem and then write about the words or phrases that pop into your mind.

Treat this collection as a personalized messenger service: Flip open the book to a random page and see what message is waiting there for you. Suggest this book to your book club or start your own *Wild Dancing Heart* Book Club.

Read a poem at special occasions, such as birthdays Mother's Day, New Year's Eve, or even a funeral.

As an experiment, take turns reading a poem to your partner each night before going to sleep. See if it calms and brightens up your relationship.

Act out a poem with passion, drama, and props as you read it — then ask a friend to act one out. This can be quite cheering and possibly hilarious. Handy for when you can't think of what to say while visiting a friend in the hospital.

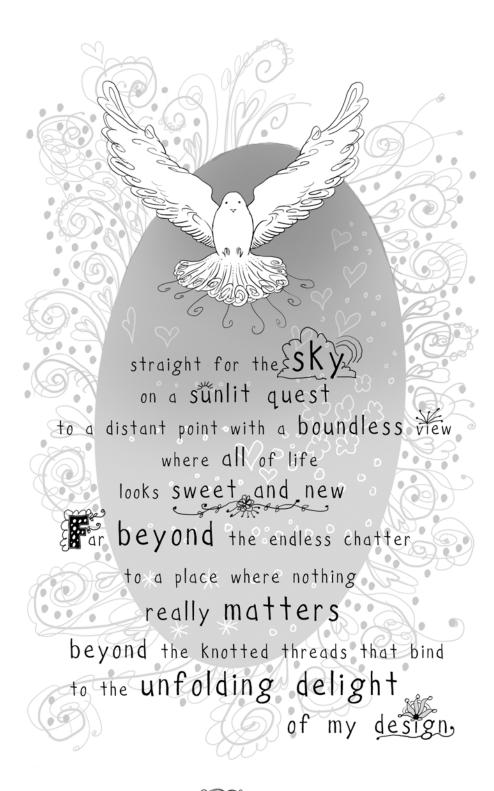


FLUTTER

friend is like having a gentle massage kneading out the knots of self-sabotage

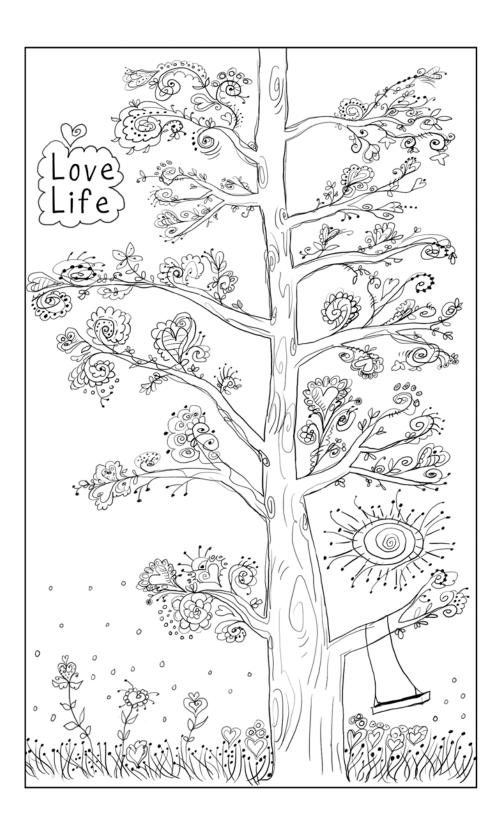
friend is like snuggling in a down comforter making me feel warm, safe and sure

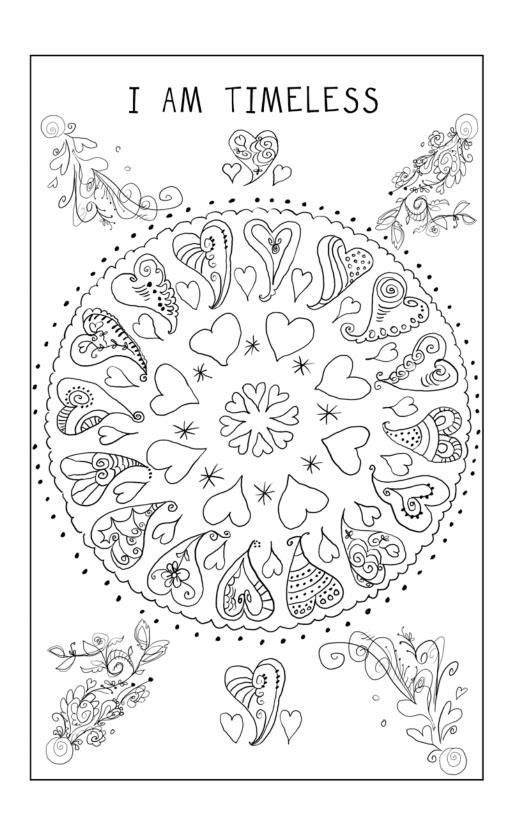

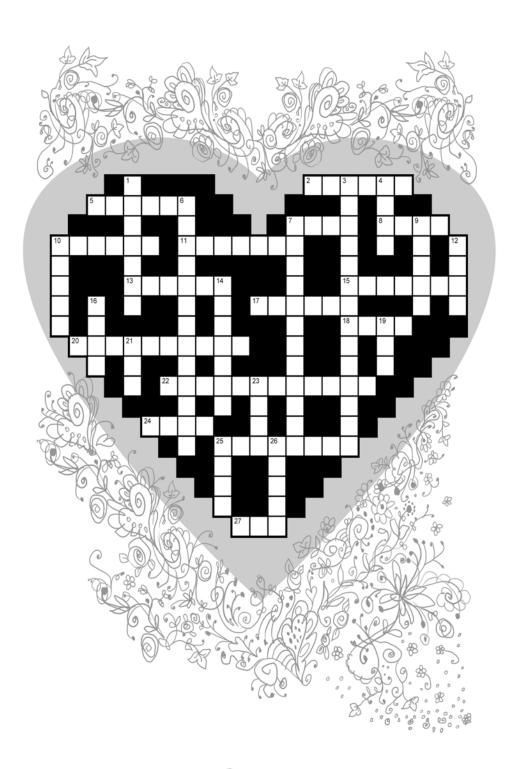
